In Rome, on November 17 at the Sala della Regina in Palazzo Montecitorio, the **Premio Leonardo Qualità Italia 2023** Awards took place, promoted by the **Leonardo Quality Committee**, which recognize quality, innovation and export vocation of companies representing Made in Italy excellence in different industrial sectors.
